The National Ovarian Cancer Coalition Sacramento Division's (N.O.C.C) first annual Tee-Off For Teal Golf Tournament is gearing up for tee time on June 5, 2006. The tournament will benefit ovarian cancer education, awareness and research.

Ovarian cancer affects one in every 55 women and because there is no early detection test for ovarian cancer, it is difficult to detect. This year 16,000 women will die from ovarian cancer due to the majority of cases that are diagnosed in the advanced stages of the disease.

"Ovarian Cancer 'Whispers' so listen," Tee-Off For Teal Committee Chair, Pattie Laubhan said. "The desire is to make people aware that there is no test for ovarian cancer. We hope to bring awareness to the community so we can diagnose the disease in its early stage (which translates to a 95 percent survival rate) and to develop a diagnostic test."

The tournament begins with a putting contest, followed by lunch and then a shotgun start. An added incentive to try and hit a hole in one is *the chance to win a 2007 Chevy Tahoe*, provided by the Hole-in One Sponsor, Performance Chevrolet. There will be no-host cocktails prior to the dinner, awards presentation and silent auction. It is a scramble tournament format. All players drive from the tee, the group then selects the best shot and players hit from there. A score per hole for each team is made until the teams hole out.

There are different levels of sponsorships including the Teal Sponsor, which includes golf for four, lunch, banquet dinner for four, tee sponsorship with sign, program advertising and banquet recognition for \$3000. The Gold Sponsor offers golf for four, lunch, banquet dinner and recognition and program listing for \$1500. The Silver Sponsor gives two the chance to golf, enjoy lunch, the banquet dinner and have recognition at the banquet as well listed in the program for \$750. There is also Beverage Cart sponsorship
